

Nine Aspects of the Tabernacle of David

- Place of Extravagant Worship
- Place Where Men, Women and Children participate equally
- Place of purity and light where no darkness can remain.
 - Revelation, Reproof, and Renovation
 - Place of Revelation and Guidance. His plan revealed.
- Place of Rule and Government / Decrees Made
- Place of Spiritual Warfare
- The Tabernacle – The Power of Corporate Action
- Place of Prayer for the Nations
- Place Where Bondage and Legalism are Removed / Healing for the Sick
- Place Where people receive an anointing which is carried with them to their homes, offices and schools.

Place of Extravagant Worship

This has been fully covered as we studied the series “The Tabernacle of David”.

Place Where Men, Women and Children Participate Fully

This aspect has been foundational to us for the past 20+ years.

Purity, Light Revelation, Reproof and Renovation

Mark 15:37-38 *And Jesus uttered a loud cry, and breathed His last.*

John 19:30 *it is finished* *teleo – paid in full*

Mark 15:38 *And the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom.*

Hebrews 10:19-21 *Therefore, brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, ²⁰by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh, ²¹and since we have a great priest over the house of God, ²²let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith,*

We are exhorted to come in with confidence and to live in face to face intimacy in God’s presence.

We are invited to live permanently behind the veil.

2 Cor 3:15-18 *But to this day whenever Moses is read, a veil lies over their heart; ¹⁶but whenever a person turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. ¹⁷Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. ¹⁸But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.*

We become like those we spend time with

I. Living Inside the Veil

A. Purity

1 John 1:5 *God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.*

1. Tarrying in God's presence causes us to desire to be Pure.

Eph 5:13 *But all things become visible when they are exposed by the light,*

2. In the presence of God you can see clearly what is good and what is not.

B. Light

1 John 1:7 *but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another*

1. fellowship – Koinonia - *partnership*, that is, (literally) *participation*,
2. Partnering with God Not working for Him but with Him
3. A common life, Shared Purpose ...

Note:

Jesus was able to do all that He did NOT because He had authority as the Son of God BUT because He did what was on the Father's heart ... a common life, a shared lifestyle.

C. Revelation

Jer 33:3 *'Call to Me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'*

Things we know	3%
Things we know we don't know	22%
Things we don't know we don't know	75%

D. Reproof or Rebuke

Hebrews 12:7 *It is for discipline that you endure; God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom his father does not discipline? ⁸But if you are without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. ⁹Furthermore, we had earthly fathers to discipline us, and we respected them; shall we not much rather be subject to the Father of spirits, and live? ¹⁰For they disciplined us for a short time as seemed best to them, but He disciplines us for our good, so that we may share His holiness. ¹¹All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.*

1. God will disciple us ... because He is a good Father ... the discipline is always better when we run to Him and admit that we need it and ask for His help.

E. Renovation

Hebrews 3:1 *Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession;*

1. Mediate, observe fully, stargaze Lie down and look at the stars ...

2. We become transformed like Him

Matthew 17:1-13

Note:

On the Mount of Transfiguration the heavenly voice of Father repeats verbatim the words of Matt 3:17 from Jesus' baptism. Just as God publicly endorsed Jesus as Messiah and Suffering Servant prior to the beginning of the main stage of His ministry, now at the beginning of the road to the cross He repeats His endorsement even more dramatically, though much less publicly. God's confirmation proves even more crucial because the notion of a suffering Messiah seemed so absurd. The heavenly voice adds the words, "Listen to Him!" Jesus must still be followed and obeyed, even as He heads off to die.

The scene is actually a picture of the Kingdom:

*Christ glorified,
the three apostles representing the redeemed Israel,
Moses representing saints who died in Christ,
Elijah representing saints who will be raptured (for Elijah did not die),
and the multitudes at the foot of the mountain representing the other nations (resistors).*

1. Transfigured – Face shone as the sun Garments white as light
God is Light
2. "Transfigure" is the same as our English word metamorphosis and means "a change from within." This glory was not the reflection of outward light; it was the revelation of inward glory. The same word is used in Rom. 12:2 ("transformed") and 2 Cor. 3:18 ("changed") referring to the Christian's growth in holiness.

Rom 12:2 *And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.*

2 Cor 3:18 *But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.*

We are not to be a reflection of Christ ... but we are to allow the glory of the Lord to radiate from our innermost being.
